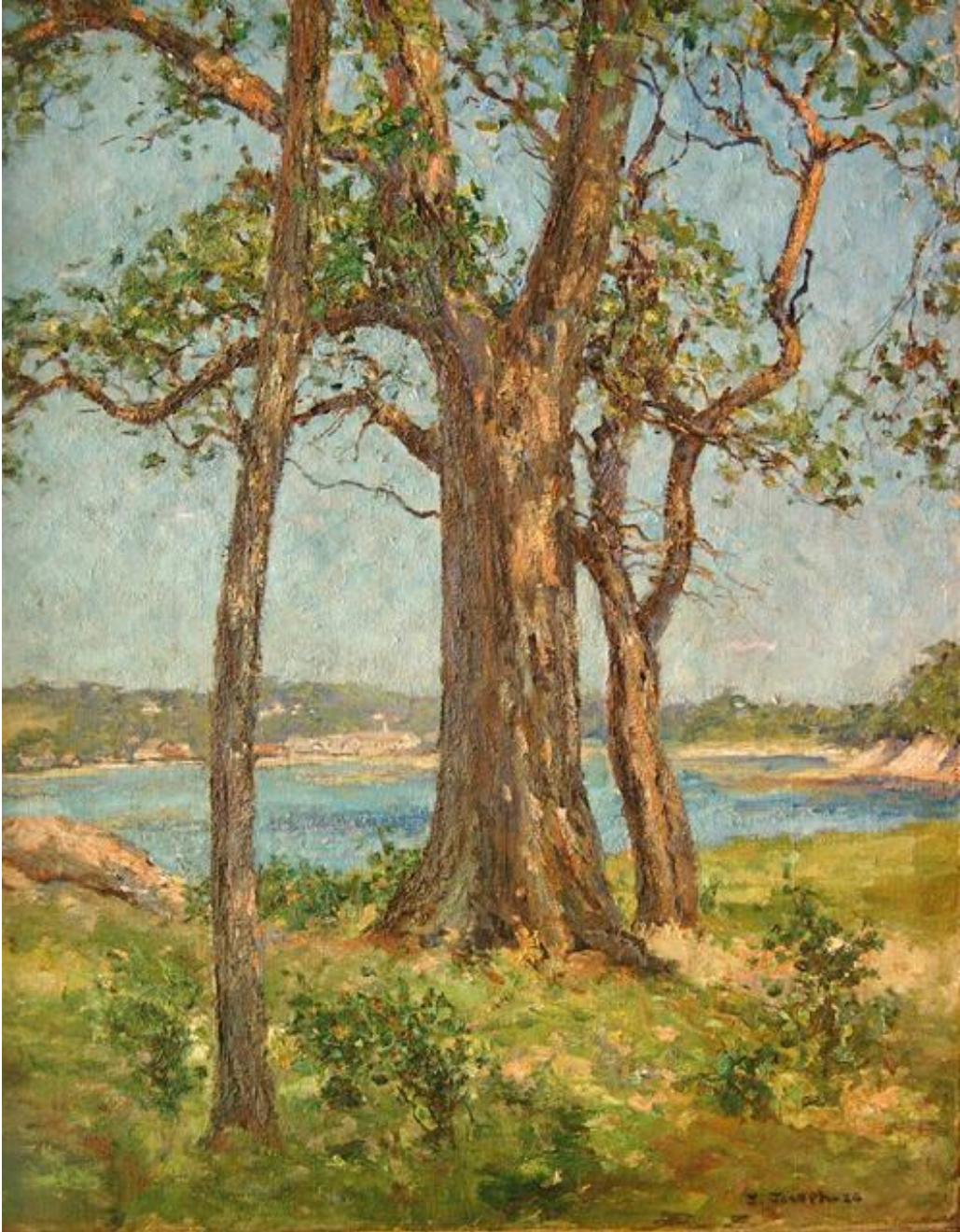

Description: The image is a landscape of three trees in the foreground and a body of water in the background.
